The Ohio Athletic Trainers' Association is soliciting abstracts of original research and clinical case reports for presentation in the Free Communications Session at the Annual Meeting and Symposium held at Columbus Marriott Northwest in Columbus, Ohio, May 4-5. Certificates of recognition for exceptional research will be awarded in the following categories: Undergraduate Athletic Training Student; Graduate Athletic Training Student; and Professional (educational topics to be considered separately from clinical topics). Continuing education units (CEUs) will be awarded for each abstract selected for presentation\*.

Abstracts submitted for presentation at the OATA meeting are also eligible for submission to the NATA meeting

Abstract content is limited to original research and clinical case studies. Literature reviews will not be accepted. Two copies of each abstract should be submitted for review. General guidelines are as follows:

**Original Research:** Abstracts must include purpose of the study or hypothesis, a description of the subjects, the experimental methods and materials, the type(s) of data analysis, the results of the study and the conclusions.

**Clinical Case Report:** Clinical case reports provide for the presentation of unique individual athletic injury cases that may be of interest to the OATA membership and should include pertinent medical history; physical findings; differential diagnosis; clinical course of injury or condition; and unique qualities of specific case.
