The Ohio Athletic Trainers' Association is soliciting abstracts for oral presentation* in the **Student Program** at the Annual Meeting and Symposium held at King Island Resort and Conference Center in Cincinnati, Ohio, May 15, 2009. Athletic Training Students are encouraged to submit proposals focusing on **Common Surgical Procedures with Rehabilitations**; however, other topics will be accepted. Proposals from professionals will not be accepted for the Student Program; submissions must be from undergraduate students.

*Oral presentations will be conducted as part of the student symposium session
Primary author must register for the OATA Annual Meeting.

Abstract content is limited to the space provided. Only abstracts submitted using the Abstract Submission Request Form will be considered. General guidelines are as follows:

Student Program Abstract: Abstracts must include: (1) Abstract, (2) Description of Surgical Procedure, (3) Unique Rehabilitation Techniques, (4) Summary and (5) Key Words.

Presentation: The presentation should discuss common surgical procedures with rehabilitation techniques unique to the surgery. Presentations will last 15 minutes in length. PowerPoint should be used.
